

## MUSIC IS THE UNIVERSAL LANGUAGE, AND IT ALL COMES TOGETHER IN NASHVILLE WHERE THE MUSIC IS WRITTEN, RECORDED AND PERFORMED.

Home to more than 180 live music venues, from the historic **Ryman Auditorium** and the **Grand Ole Opry** to independent venues such as **The Bluebird Cafe** and **3rd & Lindsley**, there is a unique experience for everyone in Music City.

With more music museums than anywhere in the world, visitors can experience the rich history of music from any genre at the **National Museum** of African American Music or the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum. Just west of downtown, visitors can hear the legendary sound recordings of Dolly Parton and Elvis Presley at Historic RCA Studio B, located on Music Row.

In recent years, there has been an evolution in both the quality of hotel rooms and quantity of rooms—from boutique to 5-star properties such as the **Four Seasons Nashville**, the **Conrad Nashville** and the **1 Hotel Nashville**—which has broadened Nashville's appeal and the visitor's experience.

The culinary scene is also hotter than ever with award winning chefs and acclaimed restaurants leaving their mark in Music City and making Nashville a premier culinary destination with over 300 new restaurants opening in the past three years. Nashville has also become a hot bed for breweries and distilleries while southern staples such as Hot Chicken, meat-and-three and Tennessee pork barbeque remain deeply embedded in the city's food culture.

Nashville is a year-round sports destination with four professional teams. In the fall, the excitement starts on Sundays with the city's NFL team the **Tennessee Titans** who are set to move into a new stadium in 2027 on the East Bank. The action continues downtown at **Bridgestone Arena**, home to the NHL's **Nashville Predators**. Nashville is also home to MLS team, the **Nashville Soccer Club**, that play at the largest soccer specific stadium—**GEODIS Park**—in the United States and Canada. The city also claims the **Nashville Sounds**, a MiLB team that recorded the highest total attendance of any team in the MiLB this past year.

Growing at a sensational pace, there's something new to experience at every corner in Music City.



Hear the Music Where Music Lives: We're proud of the title "Music City" – nowhere else can you hear such diverse sounds as Americana, country, rockabilly, jazz, blues, classical, gospel and rock n' roll. In fact, there are more than 180 live music venues in Nashville.

Hit the Hall: Kick off your Nashville experience with a day at the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum. The world's largest popular music museum offers ever-changing exhibits featuring the legends of country music past and today's hottest stars.

Ride the Row: Take a tour of Music Row and visit historic RCA Studio B, the famous recording studio where Elvis recorded over 200 songs. Roy Orbison, Dolly Parton, The Everly Brothers, Eddy Arnold and many more recorded classic hits here.

Visit the Home of The Greek Gods: In Nashville's Centennial Park, you'll find the world's only full-scale reproduction of the ancient Parthenon in Athens, Greece.

Hear Nashville's Newest
Sound: The long-awaited
National Museum of
African American Music is a
56,000-square-foot facility
that encourages visitors to
discover the central role
African Americans have played
in shaping and creating all
genres of American music, from
classical to country to jazz and
hip hop.

Take in A Songwriters-InThe-Round Show: One of the most unique ways to hear music in Nashville is at a songwriters' show. Several singer/songwriters will play "in-the-round" as they sit on stage accompanied only by a microphone, a guitar and their immense talent.

The Ryman Auditorium:
The Ryman Auditorium, also called the "Mother Church of Country Music," has had artists as diverse as Jon Bon Jovi and Patsy Cline perform on its legendary stage since 1892.

Take A Timeless Journey:
The stars of the Grand
Ole Opry take the famous
six-foot circle of wood and
perform every Tuesday, Friday
and Saturday night. With over
90 years of history, the Opry
is the world's longest-running
broadcast.

Salute: Three U.S.
Presidents called Tennessee home: Andrew Jackson,
James K. Polk and Andrew
Johnson. You can revisit the past at Andrew Jackson's Hermitage:
Home of the People's President.
Polk is buried on the grounds of the historic State Capitol building in downtown Nashville.

Visit Nashville's Neon Neighborhood: Tootsie's Orchid Lounge, Legends Corner, The Second Fiddle, The Stage, Layla's Bluegrass Inn, Robert's Western World and more are all experts at serving up cool longnecks and hot country music. Willie Nelson, Kris Kristofferson, Dierks Bentley and others began their careers on Lower Broadway.
