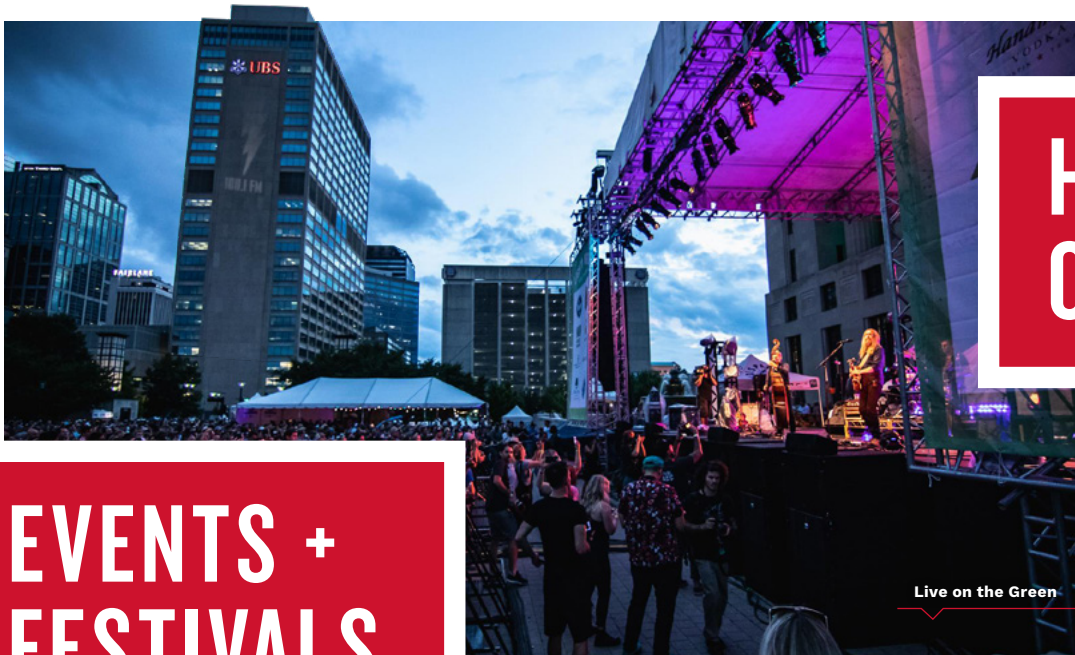

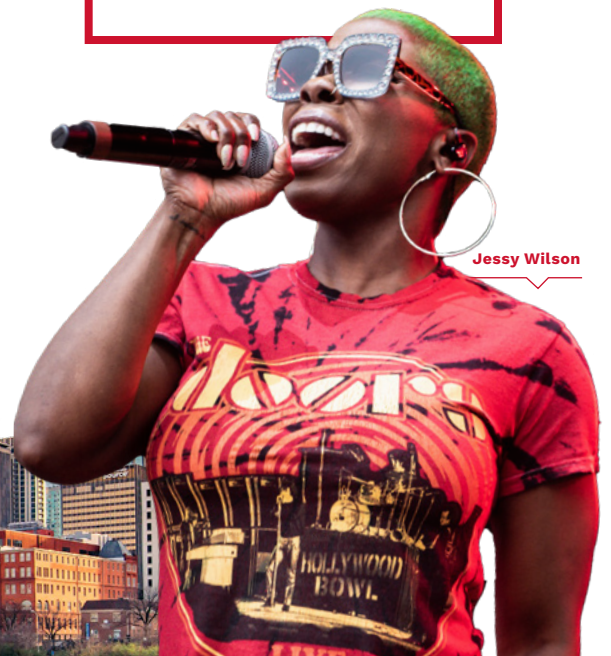

DAY ONE

Mid-Day

DAY TWO

Hear about the history at **Belle Meade Historic Site & Winery**, one of the largest thoroughbred horse farms in the South with over 5,400 acres. Tour options include everything from mansion tours, Journey to Jubilee Tours, to food and wine pairings.

Evening

DAY THREE

Morning

Begin with a tour and group recording session at **Historic RCA Studio B**, where music legends such as Elvis and Dolly recorded timeless songs. Then visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** for a self-guided tour.

Mid-Day

After the excitement of touring and performing, your group will enjoy a home-style barbecue buffet and line-dancing lesson at the famous **Wildhorse Saloon**.

After lunch, head backstage at the "Mother Church of Country Music," the **Ryman Auditorium!** **OR...**

Experience the **Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum**.

Evening

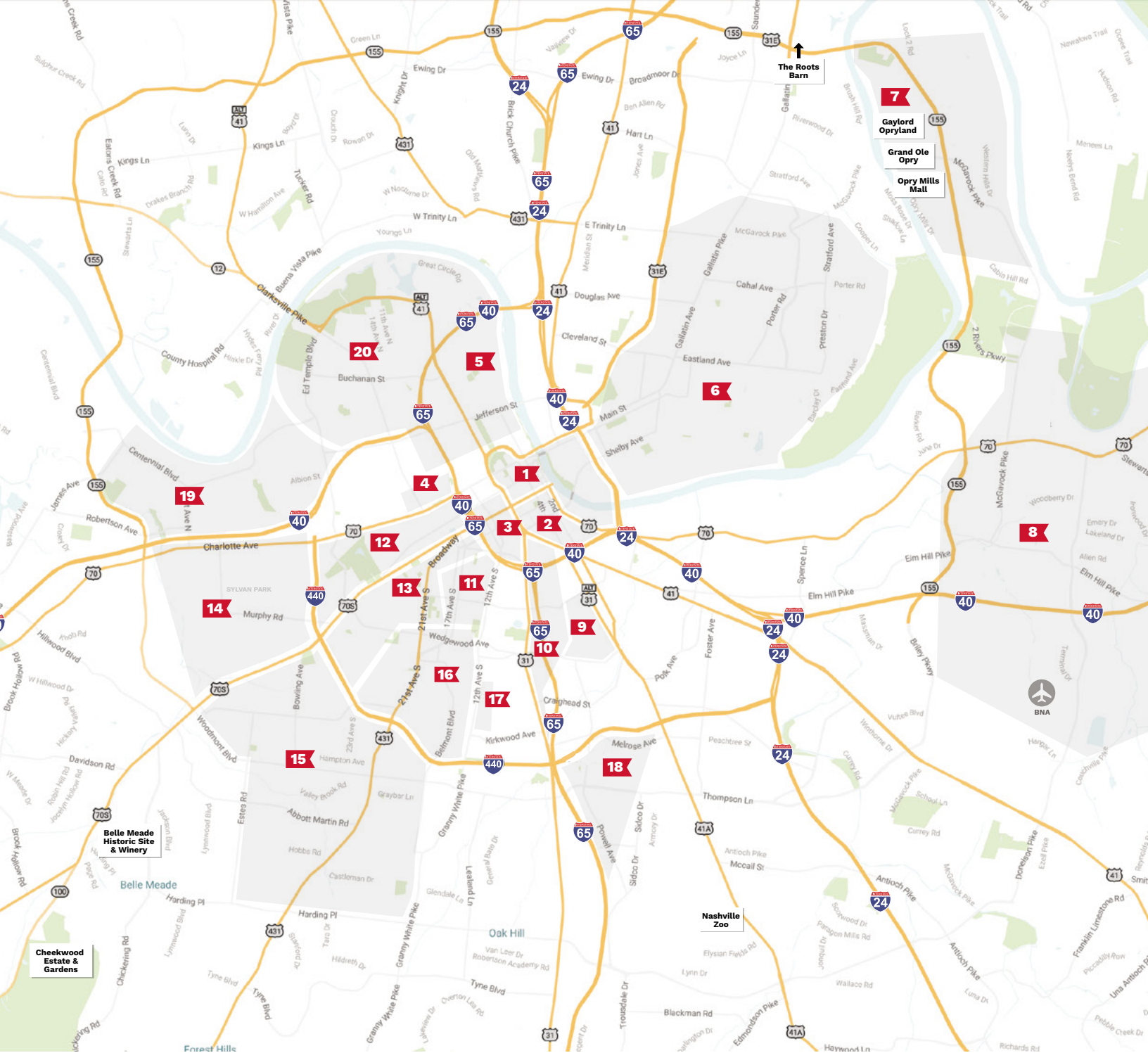
Dine at **Opry Backstage Grill, Santa Fe Cattle Co., Paula Deen's Family Kitchen**, or enjoy free time and dinner at **Opry Mills Mall**. Include a visit to **Madame Tussauds Nashville** before catching a show at the **Grand Ole Opry** – Nashville's must-see attraction and the world's longest-running live radio show. Conclude your day with an **Opry Backstage Tour**.

Free Time

If you've got some free time on your hands, we've got you covered.

Explore the city at your own pace with **Gray Line** or **Old Town Trolley Tours** hop-on/hop-off. You will stop at over 15 locations throughout Music City, with opportunities to shop, eat, drink, be entertained, and much more!

If you have a full day, take the scenic ride down to **Jack Daniel's Distillery**, the oldest registered distillery in the United States and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visitors receive personally-guided tours of the distillery and observe the famous whiskey-making process.
