DAY ONE Mid-Day

Visit Nashville's newest museum, the National Museum of African American Music, located downtown inside the new Fifth + Broadway. Have lunch at Assembly Food Hall before exploring the 235,000 square foot entertainment destination.

Afternoon

Stretch your legs as you walk in the footsteps of the stars and discover the stories of Music Row's vibrant past and present with a guided **Music Row Walking Tour** led by **Let's Go Travelin'**.

End your journey on Music Row at legendary **Sound Stage Studios**. Your group will sit side-by-side with Nashville's top session pros as they experience a live recording session with one of Nashville's newest attractions, **Imagine Recordings**.

Evening

Keep the music going with dinner and a songwriter show at the Listening Room Café. This Nashville venue is sure to give your group an authentic Nashville experience! Afterwards, spend some free time on Nashville's Honky Tonk Highway and experience some of the best music in town. You never know who you will run into on Lower Broadway!

DAY TWO

Morning

Journey back in time at Andrew Jackson's Hermitage: Home of the People's President. OR...

Take a little break and escape into Cheekwood Estate & Gardens. If you come during the peak seasons, Tulips in Spring, Harvest in Autumn, and Holiday LIGHTS during Christmas are a must!

Mid-Day

Hear about the history at Belle Meade Historic Site & Winery, one of the largest thoroughbred horse farms in the South with over 5,400 acres. Tour options include everything from mansion tours, Journey to Jubilee Tours, to food and wine pairings.

Evening

After lunch, head backstage at the "Mother Church of Country Music,"

the Ryman Auditorium! OR...

Experience the Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum.

Evening


Dine at Opry Backstage Grill,

Free Time

If you've got some free time on your hands, we've got you covered.

Explore the city at your own pace with **Gray Line** or **Old Town Trolley Tours** hop-on/hop-off. You will stop at over 15 locations throughout Music City, with opportunities to shop, eat, drink, be entertained, and much more!

If you have a full day, take the scenic ride down to Jack Daniel's Distillery, the oldest registered distillery in the United States and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visitors receive personally-guided tours of the distillery and observe the famous whiskey-making process.
